

PostScript Engraver Text Fonts Read Me

Attached you will find updated versions of four PostScript Engraver fonts: EngraverTextT, EngraverTextH, EngraverTextNCS, EngraverTime.

Due to the lack of headers in the old PS Engraver Mac text fonts, Engraver PS text fonts are not being properly selected in Finale 2014. All Engraver text fonts have been updated from the old PS .suit format to OpenTypeMPS.

Traditionally, even though these are text fonts, these have been included in the macsymbolfonts.txt. As many of you know, text fonts should not be included in this list as upper ASCII characters may not display correctly. There are a handful of characters in EngraverTextT, EngraverTextH, and EngraverTextNCS that will not display if these fonts are included in the macsymbolfonts.txt, namely: 8va, 8vb, ca., a negative width subscript “B”, a negative width subscript “D”, 8ba, 15ma, and a bullet. If these are needed glyphs, you will need to remove these font names from your macsymbolfonts.txt.

To install these fonts, use FontBook to first disable or remove all old versions, then install the updated versions.
